WestEd announces the newest cycle of the Family Partnership Initiative Training-of-Trainer Institutes. The Family Partnership Initiative (FPI) Training-of-Trainers Institute provides participants with techniques to enhance partnerships between families and staff serving children birth to 12 years, in state-funded, child development programs and family child care home networks. The Institute is designed for **leaders** in the field of child development who impact the professional development of practitioners in their region. This may include teacher trainers, program leaders, consultants, and family leaders.

The FPI Institute focuses on offering strategies that programs can use with families and staff to jointly support children's learning and development, to highlight the strengths each member brings to the partnership, and to explore innovative ways to nurture these partnerships with all families and staff to implement.

The schedule for this year's Family Partnership Initiative Training-of-Trainer Institutes is as follows:
